You are going to be creating the first slide for your Jeopardy game. The above image is an example of what it would look like. This slide is going to have 6 rows and 5 columns.

Your top row is going to be the different categories. For this row you are going to go to Home->Shapes. Once there, use the Rectangle to make this row. For the top row change the background color.

For the columns under the categories go to Home->Shapes. Once there, use the Bevel shape under Basic Shapes to create your columns. This shape looks like this.



Change the background color for your columns. Make sure the background color for your columns is a different color than the top row.

When you put the category names on the first row of your slide go to Home->Text Box to name the categories. Make sure you change the color of the text.

When you put in the question amounts on the columns go to Home->Text Box to put in the amounts. Make sure you underline the amounts and change the color of the amounts.

When you are done with this slide the Rectangle and Bevel shapes you use to make your columns and rows should all be the same size and fill the entire slide.
